

12. The Findings of Facts set out above are hereby incorporated herein as Conclusions of Law as if set out herein verbatim.
13. The interests of the minor child have been considered by his attorney, and there are no objections to awarding [REDACTED] sole legal and physical custody in this matter.

ORDERS

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

I.

Sole Legal Custody. [REDACTED] is a fit and proper person to be awarded sole legal custody of the parties' minor child. "Sole legal custody" means an award of legal custody of the child to one parent only, under which only that parent has legal custodial rights and responsibilities toward the child and that parent has legal custodial rights superior to those of the other parent. Rights and responsibilities of sole legal custody include, but are not limited to, control in making decisions affecting the child's legal status, medical care, education, extracurricular activities and religious instruction.

II.

Sole Physical Care and Custody. [REDACTED] is granted sole physical care and custody of the minor child. "Physical care" means the right and responsibility to maintain a home for the child and provide for their routine care.

III.

Income Tax Exemptions, Deductions and Credits. [REDACTED] shall have the right to claim the minor child on his Federal and State tax returns for all credit and exceptions.
